TTP hits 70% export target and gains recognition as leader in technology export with The Queen's Award for Enterprise.

Melbourn, Cambs, UNDER EMBARGO UNTIL 21ST APRIL 2008: TTP Group plc (TTP) has been awarded The Queen's Award for Enterprise in the International Trade Category in recognition of its contribution to the growing UK export market. With the UK's total export figures increasing by 6% in January this year to £20billion, TTP has developed a fierce reputation for developing world-class technologies for export into competitive global markets.

Peter Taylor, CEO of TTP, commented: "At a time when Asia is considered by some to be a dominant region for export of technology, we are proud to be a UK company bucking the trend and taking our technology to Japan, as well as to the rest of the world. We work with a global network of partners to develop advanced technology that is incorporated into products that are used in everyday life all over the world."

TTP was presented with The Queen's Award for Enterprise in the International Trade Category due to its impressive annual export revenue of more than £20m – over 70% of its total income. The company's technology lies behind many of the world's leading products and processes in areas as diverse as digital printing, communications, instrumentation, consumer & industrial products, medical devices, drug discovery, cleantech and security systems.

For example, TTP's innovative technology lies behind the very successful InBev Perfectdraft, a home beer dispenser which is sold under the Philips brand across Europe. In the medical sector, its proprietary electronic aerosol technology enables the revolutionary nebuliser, offered by Pari, to be sold worldwide to bring relief to sufferers of cystic fibrosis. In the emerging cleantech sector one of TTP's unique high efficiency piezo electric actuator technologies has been licenced to a major Japanese company in the fuel cell market. Its LabTech subsidiary exports over 80% of its advanced instrumentation for drug discovery around the world and has recently established an office in China to support this business.

As well as undertaking totally funded development work for its clients, TTP also works with partners to co-fund advanced technology developments in return for license rights to exploit the resulting intellectual property. It has offices in the US and China and long-standing relationships with partner companies in Japan.
